Principal's News

Kia ora te whānau - Greetings to all our families

This week I want to congratulate Mr Paul Tyson who has recently been appointed by the Board to the position of Deputy Principal here at Marshland for 2018. As a bigger school now, it was time to appoint another Deputy Principal along with Riki Culley. Paul will work alongside Riki and me as part of the Senior leadership team.



As well, the Board has recently appointed two other teachers to join our team for 2018. Terry van der Schaaf who comes to us from Redwood School, will teach year 3 children in

2018 and Samantha Jones who comes to us from St Joseph's school will teach children in the Nest in 2018. We congratulate these two teachers and welcome them to the Marshland whānau. We still have another position to fill and we are working on that one now. Exciting times!

The roll continues to grow and we will finish the year with around 456 students. Next year, I think the roll will be

around 475 students by the end of the year. This is mainly due to the numbers of families moving into the Prestons Park subdivision.

A reminder to everyone to not leave scooters behind at school. We recently had a scooter stolen and stripped for parts that was left in the scooter stands. Fortunately, we had it all on our security cameras, and were able to apprehend the culprit.

Our futsal court is now completed, along with an extra strip of artificial grass as an extra hard area for children. The children will be able to start playing Futsal very soon. We can also see lots of grass starting to sprout up, which is exciting. Some irrigation and an improved drainage solution is also in place. We will keep the children off the grass for probably the rest of the term to make sure it gets a really good chance to grow.

The next area to be worked on will be the barked area close to the Nest. We are getting some good ideas for that coming in, and think it will work well as an area for our little New Entrant children, something to bridge the gap between preschool and school maybe.

KEEP YOUR CHILDREN SAFE ON THEIR WAY TO AND FROM SCHOOL:

This week we have had two more phone calls from concerned members of the public regarding near-misses involving Marshland School children on the road. *(This block contains a large amount of garbled text that appears to be a corrupted link or a placeholder.)*

Earlier this week two older boys scootered out in front of a truck in Te Korari Street and were very narrowly missed. After school yesterday we received another report of a very close call after a child ran straight across Prestons Road without looking, against a red light, and was very nearly collected by a vehicle. Parents - can you PLEASE make sure your children are road safety aware before you allow them to walk, scooter or bike to school unsupervised. Stress the importance of looking both ways before they cross the road (if they scooter in groups they can often get side-tracked and don't concentrate). Emphasise the importance of traffic lights and how to cross at lights. This



could be your child, so please take this warning seriously.
